



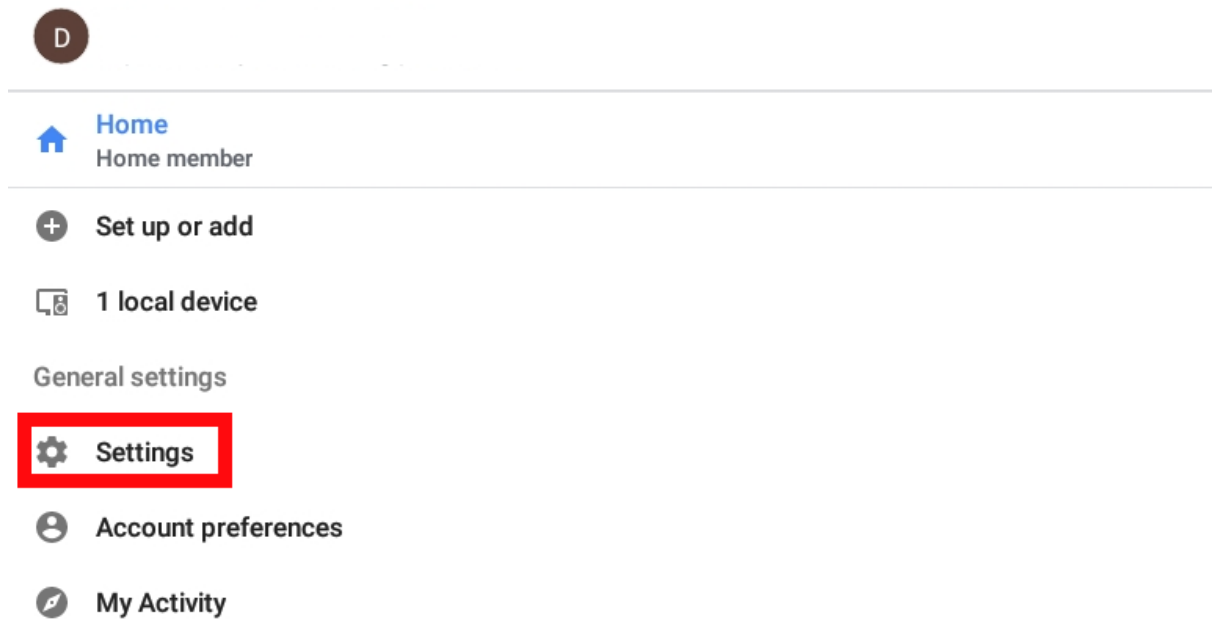
Native Google Home Integration

For Vera Home Controllers

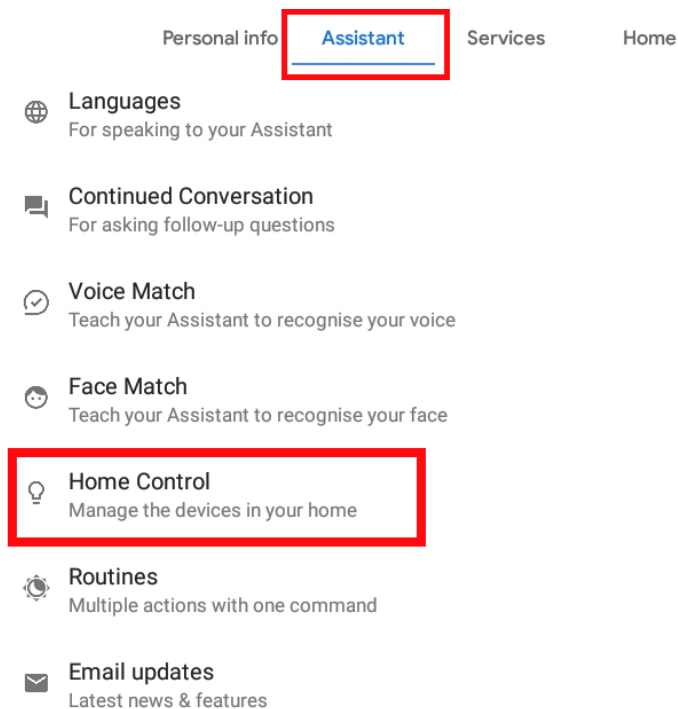
Firstly you will need your Vera Controller Updated to the Latest firmware Version, this will also automatically install the Google Home App on your Vera Controller so you will not need to do anything else with your Vera.

1. Load up the Google Home app on your device and access settings

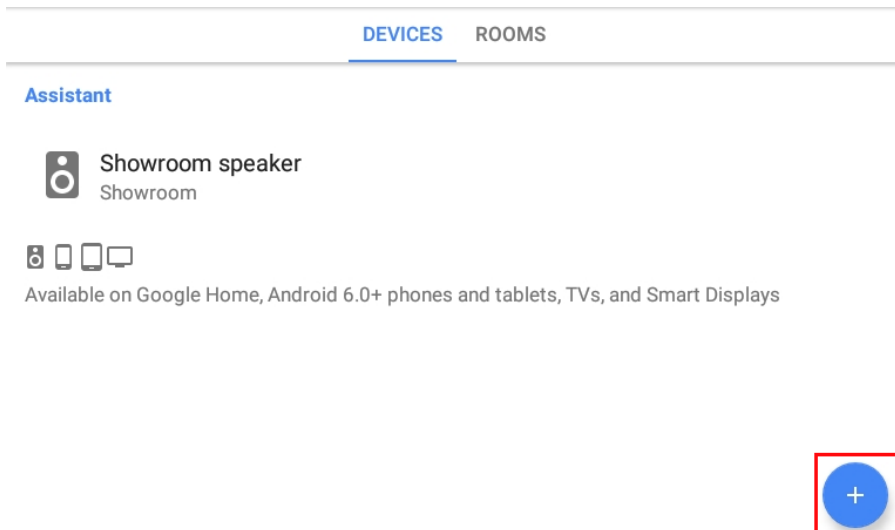

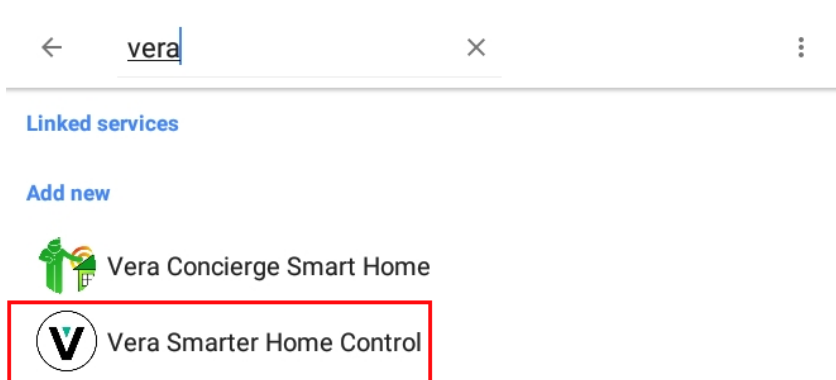
2. Then under the Assistant Tab select Home Control



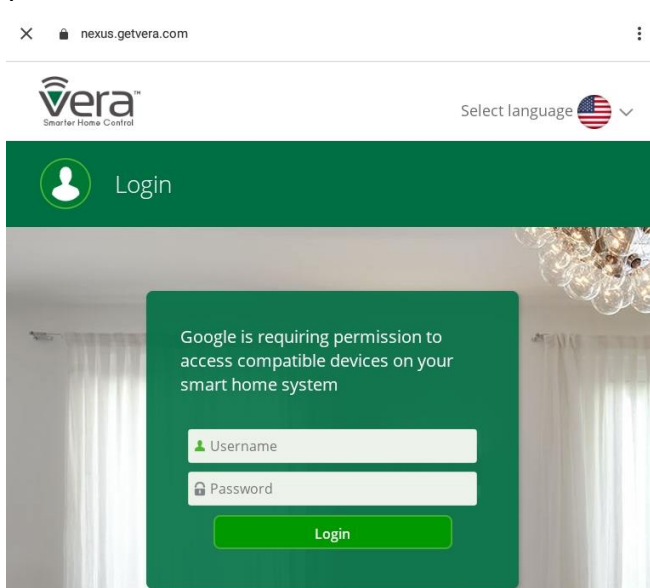
3. Under this Menu Press the Add button to the Bottom right of the screen



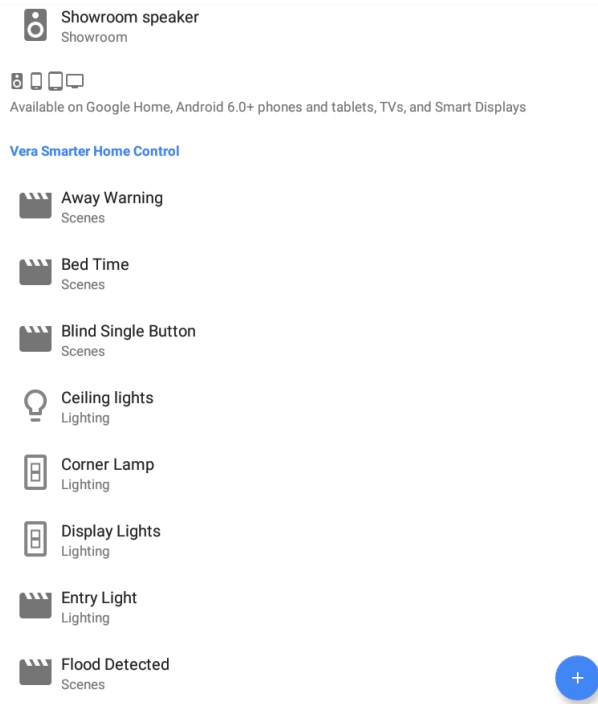
4. Use the Search function to find the 'Vera Smarter Home Control' Service



5. Once you press on the 'Vera Smarter Home Control' you will be asked to connect your Vera Account.



6. After you have linked your account you will be asked to add any devices that are not in a room to a room, you may skip this, after this you will have a screen showing all of your Devices and Scenes that have been linked to your Google Home.



Something that is worth noting is at this current point in time you are unable to select which devices you don't want your Google Home to be able to control.

Security devices are not controllable such as locks for security reasons.
